



Important Fraud Alert

We have received reports of an entity calling itself XTO Australia falsely representing itself as part of CIM Group. The entity may be attempting to sell an AI investment scheme.

Please note that any such communications do not originate from our organization. If you receive a communication that appears to be from CIM Group but seems unusual or suspicious, please get in touch with your CIM Group representative directly.

What You Should Know

- CIM Group will only communicate with you through authorized company channels.
- Be cautious of suspicious unsolicited emails, phone calls, text messages, or social media messages claiming to represent CIM Group.
- Do not provide confidential, personal, financial, or account information in response to suspicious communications.
- Do not send funds or execute transactions based on instructions that have not been independently verified.

If you believe you have been contacted by an individual or organization falsely claiming to represent CIM Group, please forward any relevant information, including emails, phone numbers, or supporting documentation, to emailupdates@cimgroup.com.

We take these matters seriously and will work with the appropriate parties to address this issue.
